Lincoln High School collaborates with families and the community to provide each student with challenging and engaging programs in a responsive and supportive environment. Lincoln High School was built in 1923 on scenic Roeff's Hill along the Lake Michigan shore. The school's original garden setting was designed by noted Prairie School landscape architect Jens Jensen. The classic gothic-style building occupies a 19-acre campus.

Lincoln is proud to offer students the most comprehensive spectrum of academic and elective programming on the lakeshore, and is one of only 15 high schools in Wisconsin to offer the International Baccalaureate program. In addition, Lincoln partners with the University of Wisconsin-Manitowoc, Silver Lake College, and Lakeshore Technical College to provide on-site, dual credit courses that provide students with academic rigor and the opportunity to gain advanced standing at most of Wisconsin's public and private colleges and universities. Students have extensive opportunities at Lincoln including athletics, co-curricular activities and youth apprenticeships.

What makes Lincoln High School special?

- In addition to the International Baccalaureate (IB) program, students have many course options including AP courses in English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies; Art; Business; Career and Technical Education; Family & Consumer Education; Global Scholar Program; French, German, Spanish and Japanese; Music; Technology and more.
- Students complete 20 hours of community service. They work with community leaders and professionals, learn first-hand about societal issues, explore career possibilities and experience the satisfaction that comes from volunteering and helping others.
